## **June 12-15 Little Picassos**

Grades: 1<sup>st</sup>-4<sup>th</sup>      Fee: **\$60**      Instructor: Malori Giannaris      Max #: 15

In this class, students are introduced to basic art techniques, providing a solid foundation for future art lovers and artists. Children explore the great world of art using oil pastels, clay, paper, and paint. Each day features a new lesson, learning about a famous artist and a new project. This unique learning experience places an emphasis on having fun while exploring creativity! "Little Picassos" is led by local artist and art educator, Malori Giannaris. **Students need to bring an old, oversized T-shirt to wear over their clothing.**

## **June 19-22 Crafty Kids**
