Dear Parent(s) or Legal Guardian(s):

Thank you for having an interest in Copoliah-Lincoln Community College's Summer 2023 Programming and Robotics Camp. Below you will find information that will help you prepare your child for camp. For your child to participate in this camp, you need to:

1. Fill out the entire registration form.
2. Sign the youth release of liability form.
3. Pay the \$80 registration fee.

Camp will begin on Monday, June 12, 2023, and camp will end Thursday, June 15, 2023. Daily times are from 12:00PM – 3:00PM.

The first 20 participants to submit completed paperwork will be enrolled, but registration will remain open until filled.

DAILY SCHEDULE

Camp will operate from 12:00 p.m. until 3:00 p.m. Monday, June 12 –Thursday, June 15. Participant drop off will be from 11:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. at the Dow Young Instructional Technology building in room 121 at the Copoliah-Lincoln Community College Wesson Campus. Pick-up will commence at 3:00 p.m. and last until 3:30 p.m. in Dow Young 121. It is expected that parents will come into Dow Young and sign in/out participants daily.

Daily Topics:

Monday: Intro to Programming: We will use a variety of coding games to get campers used to coding logic. Then we will have an introduction to the Python programming language.

Tuesday: More with Python: We will show campers various control structures in Python and use projects to help campers put these topics to use.

Wednesday: Introduction to Lego Mindstorm: Campers will build Lego EV3 robots and learn how to program these robots to perform tasks.

Thursday: More with Lego Mindstorm: Campers will use their built EV3 robots to perform various activities.

FOOD & WATER

Lunch will NOT be provided, so please ensure your child has a well-balanced lunch prior to camp or pack them a non-perishable lunch.

ITEMS TO BRING TO CAMP EVERYDAY

- Willingness to Learn, Patience, and a Positive Attitude!

Learning to program takes time and patience. Programming is learned mostly by making mistakes and learning from them.

BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS

Since this is a structured and educational recreation camp, youth are expected to treat each other, staff, camp equipment, and the public with respect. Our goal is to provide campers with a physically and emotionally safe atmosphere. Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated. Physical bullying (i.e. pushing, hitting, fighting) and emotional bullying (i.e. name calling, teasing, put downs, racial/ethnic slurs) will not be tolerated. Behavior mentioned above will be grounds for immediate dismissal from the camp, whether it is directed towards other campers, camp staff, or the public. Campers that are the target of such behavior must inform camp staff of the incident immediately. Behavioral guidelines are to be followed at all times regardless of the location of the activities. **If a child is expelled from camp, the child may not return to camp, and there will be no registration refunds.** In cases where there are major behavioral issues, the below sequences will take place:

MAJOR BEHAVIORAL CONSEQUENCES
1st Offense – Warning
2nd Offense – Time Out, Parent Phone Call
3rd Offense – Expulsion (Parent Pick-Up)
