**Academic Advisement Worksheet for the Associate Degree Nursing Program**

Applications for the ADN program are accepted at the ADN office between January 1st and April 5th of each year.

1) **ACT REQUIREMENT:** All applicants must have an ACT composite score of 18 or higher.

*Submission of an ACT composite score is REQUIRED for this program.*

**AND**

2) **CUMULATIVE GPA REQUIREMENT:** All applicants **must** have a **cumulative GPA of 2.50** or higher on a 4.00 scale for all previous college work attempted.

**AND**

3) **PRE-REQUISITE COURSES:** All pre-requisite courses **must** be completed prior to entering the nursing program with a **minimum grade of “C” and taken within 8 years of applying.** **In order to apply to the nursing program, applicant must have completed or be currently enrolled in final pre-requisite courses.** In exceptional cases, the applicant can be admitted into the program pending summer completion of final pre-requisite(s).
