UPDATES:

1. CSC 1613 Computer Programming I can substitute for MSU's CSE 1284 (this course satisfies the ME programming requirement – either CSE 1233 or CSE 1284 are options our on-campus students enroll in);
2. If PHY 2313 and/or PHY 2323 cannot be taken, then it is advised that students should pick to take CHE 1223 (General Chemistry II) and CHE 1221 (General Chemistry II Lab) or BIO 1143 (General Biology II) and BIO 1141 (General Biology II Lab).
3. If students need an elective, then it is advised that students should pick a literature elective or take a science with lab from the list of CHE 1223 and CHE 1221, BIO 1143 and BIO 1141, or PHY 2333.

NOTES:

1. Please consult with the curriculum from the catalog of the university to which you plan to transfer for specific courses that can be taken at Co-Lin.
2. Acceptance of community college work is limited to one-half of the total degree hour requirement for graduation in a given curriculum.
3. It is the student's responsibility to review the Mississippi Statewide Articulation Agreement called the [MATT Transfer Tool](#) for courses accepted by each Mississippi public university.
