The fire safety system of Copiah-Lincoln Community College includes fire extinguishers and fire hydrants around each campus housing facility. Smoke detectors are placed in every campus housing room. Alarms are also located throughout each campus housing facility along with diagrams of fire evacuation routes. Additional cameras were placed in Stevens Hall in 2013 to deter fire alarms being pulled. This has been effective.

If a fire should occur, an immediate call to Campus Police or the Dormitory Host/Hostess should be made. The Wesson Fire Department may also be called in case of a fire.

Campus Housing College Catalog/Student Handbook for 2021-2022. **They include:**

Microwave ovens and apartment-type refrigerators are allowed, but not toaster ovens, hot plates, fryers or air fryers. Fire and insurance regulations prohibit the burning of any material in the residence halls. Candles, incense, and wax-melters are not permitted.

Smoking is prohibited on all areas of campus.

IN CASE OF FIRE:

1. If a fire exists, activate the building alarm.
2. Notify Campus Police or your Dormitory Host/Hostess.
3. When the alarm is sounded, walk quickly to the nearest marked exit and alert others to do the same. Report to your dormitory staging area. Stevens Hall residents should NOT use elevators.
4. Students with hearing disabilities and/or other disabilities will have designated roommates, suite-mates and Dorm Host/Hostesses responsible for assisting them during such emergencies.
5. Do not return to an evacuated building or site unless authorized by a member of the Emergency Operations Team.
6. During evacuations, direct crowds away from fire hydrants, roadways and clear sidewalks immediately adjacent to the building. Ask bystanders to assist in watching windows, doorways, etc. for persons that may be trapped inside. **DO NOT ATTEMPT TO RESCUE. NOTIFY EMERGENCY RESPONDENTS OR FIRE DEPARTMENT PERSONNEL.**
7. Dorm Host/Hostesses should notify Campus Police of a break or suspected break in utility lines which may present an additional hazard. Campus Police will notify Maintenance and utility companies.
8. Remain at your staging area until the “all clear” is given.
