



Radiologic Technology Information Sheet

Admission Requirements

- 1. Complete and have on file a Copiah-Lincoln Community College official application.
- 2. Complete Radiologic Technology (RGT) Application and return to the RGT program.
- 3. Must have a transcript from an accredited high school showing graduation, or GED equivalency, or a transcript from previous college attendance on file with:

- 4. ACT score must be on file in the Office of College Admissions. *Composite score of 18 required.*
- 5. Have two letters of recommendation mailed to the RGT program.
- 6. Attend Radiologic Technology program tour. *See back for scheduled tour dates.*
- 7. Selection committee reviews RGT application packet and records.
- 8. If selected, participate in drug and alcohol testing and criminal history background check.

*Admission to the program is on a competitive basis.

The Copiah-Lincoln Radiologic program accepts a limited number of students for each fall semester.
 Selection is based on completed RGT Application Packet, ACT, GPA, and review score.

Must be 18 years or older upon entrance into the program.

What if my ACT score indicates that I need developmental courses or Intermediate Algebra?

These courses must be successfully completed before entrance into the Radiologic Technology program.
