



Copiah-Lincoln Community College Scholarship Guidelines

Please note the following requirements to be considered for Institutional Scholarships:

- Students who apply before **March 1st** will be given priority in the awarding of scholarships.
- Students must submit an ACT score to the College and be a resident of Mississippi to be considered for a scholarship.
- Scholarship recipients must maintain continuous full-time enrollment (a minimum of 15 credit hours per semester is required for academic scholarship recipients). Scholarship recipients dropping below full-time status or withdrawing from school will lose their scholarship and will not be reinstated.
- Scholarships will be awarded for four semesters unless otherwise noted.
- Scholarships may be stacked; however, students will not receive any combination of scholarships valued over the cost of attendance for Co-Lin as determined for Federal student aid.
- Academic scholarship recipients must maintain a 3.0 grade point average (GPA) and Recognition and Service recipients must maintain a 2.0 GPA. The grade point averages will be checked at the end of each semester. Foundation scholarships have specific GPA requirements.
- Academic scholarships are for first-time entering freshmen who enter in the fall or spring semester immediately following their senior year of high school.
- Academic scholarships are not available for transfer students.

Academic Scholarships

Achievement Scholarship - (19-20 ACT) \$350/semester

Honors Scholarship - (21-24 ACT) \$700/semester

Deans' Scholarship – (25 & 26 ACT) \$1400/semester

Vice Presidents' Scholarship - (27 & 28 ACT) \$1400/semester and \$250/semester Book/eResource Voucher

President's Scholarship - (29+ ACT/National Merit/Achievement) \$1400/semester, Room, Meals and a \$250/semester Book/eResource Voucher

Valedictorian/Salutatorian Scholarship - \$1,000 award per year for two years/\$500 per semester - Student must have a minimum 21 ACT and confirmation from the high school counselor is required.

Leadership & Recognition Scholarships

Foundation Scholarships - These scholarships are made possible by individual donations to the College. Most foundation scholarships have specific requirements such as grade point average, residence, program of study, etc. Applications are available January 1st each year with a priority deadline of March 1st.

Leadership Scholarships - These scholarships are one time awards in the amounts of \$500 or \$1,000 for the freshmen year only. Scholarships will be used to reward outstanding leadership among students through their high school and/or community service activities.
