STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships are a critical tool in both recruiting and retaining students at Co-Lin. Named endowed scholarship funds may be established with a minimum gift of \$10,000, where 5% is awarded annually and the principle fund is never invaded. Students are chosen by a college selection committee in consultation with the donor. Annual gifts of \$500 or more may also be donated to an annual named scholarship.

FACULTY DEVELOPMENT

Gifts to this fund enable faculty to take advantage of professional developmental opportunities. Endowments may be established with a minimum gift of \$10,000, or gifts of \$250 or more may be given to establish an annual award for faculty.

BIG WOLF CLUB

Gifts to this fund serve to provide supplemental funds for various athletic programs of the college. A separate Back the Pack athletic facilities capital campaign is ongoing. Gifts of any amount are accepted.
