## UNIVERSITY-SPECIFIC CONSIDERATIONS

### MSU

- o requires at least 3 science courses (2 must have the corresponding lab), at least one must be a life science with lab, and at least one must be a physical science with lab
- o requires college algebra and one higher level mathematics course
- o requires one literature course and one history course
- o only needs Spanish I & II or can test at 2<sup>nd</sup> semester fluency
- o PSY/EPY 2533 transfers as EPY 2533 and will be used as a general elective

#### USM

- o no foreign languages required
- o requires 9 hours of humanities, one of which must be World Literature

#### DSU

- o requires PSY 1513 and PHI 2113
- o requires one history and one literature
- no foreign languages required

### UM

- o requires 9-11 hours in science courses (2 must have the corresponding lab), two courses must be from the same subject, with a third from a different department
- o requires 15 hours in humanities: 6 hours in literature, 6 hours in history, and 1 additional humanities course
- o accepts 6-12 hours in foreign language

#### MUW (B.A.)

- o humanities: 1 history, 1 literature, 1 fine art, a 2<sup>nd</sup> in history, literature, or fine arts
- o 9 hours in social science, one of which must be PHI 2113
- o accepts 6-12 hours in foreign language

## MUW (B.S.)

- o additional 6 semester hours of science and/or mathematics
- additional 3 semester hours of mathematics above MAT 1313 or 1314 or computer applications/programming course

#### JSU

- o science courses need to be BIO I & II with labs with additional 3 hours in a natural science
- o 9 hours in social science, one of which must be PHI 2113
- o will accept MAT 2323
