

Practical Nursing Program Admissions Policy

- 1. Applications are reviewed for accuracy and to verify if applicant meets the admission criteria.
- 2. The following items must be submitted for college enrollment:
 - a. Copiah-Lincoln Community College Application
 - b. Official transcript from high school or GED/HSE scores
 - c. Official transcript from any colleges attended
- 3. The following items must be submitted for the Practical Nursing Program:
 - a. Practical Nursing Program Application
 - b. ACT composite score of 16 or higher 14 or higher in reading and math
 - c. ATI TEAS In-Person Exam scores
- 4. Selections are based off the highest scores on the admission rubric. The top fifteen scores are chosen for each class. Five alternates are chosen based on the five highest remaining scores.
 - a. In the event of a tie, a current Co-Lin student is given priority. If applicants are both Co-Lin students, the in-district student will be chosen. If there is still a tie, the highest points from the categories listed in order will be selected:
 - i. Prior courses points
 - ii. Overall college GPA
 - iii. TEAS composite score
 - iv. ACT composite score
